OUTLINE

POINTS

A minimum of **40 points** must be accrued in each **two year** period, with a minimum of 15 points in each calendar year.
Points must be accrued in three of the following four categories, with category 1 being mandatory for all RMTs.

EVIDENCE

All items submitted must be accompanied by appropriate evidence. All evidence must be in English.
Evidence of attendance at course, workshops, events, etc, must include:

- Name of event
- Name of presenter
- Signature of presenter or their delegate
- Attendee (your) name
- Dates and times, detailing hours of direct contact
- Contact details of organiser

SUBMISSION

Your submission is able to be edited by you until midnight on 28th (or 29th) February in the year you are due to submit.
After this point your submission is locked for review by the CPD committee.

The CPD portal is live; as such there no button to click in order to submit.
Once you have entered your activities and evidence, your submission is complete.
