INFORMATION ABOUT STUDENT MEMBERSHIP WITH THE AUSTRALIAN MUSIC THERAPY ASSOCIATION

This is an information sheet designed to give students who are currently enrolled in an accredited Australian Music Therapy (AMTA) Course an outline of the benefits and responsibilities of being a student member of the association. Application forms can be found on the website. If the student is currently enrolled in a course that is accredited by AMTA, they are eligible to apply.

Benefits of Registration

By joining the Association whilst you are still a student, you have the opportunity to gain further knowledge about what it means to be an RMT, begin to form networks which will assist you when you start to seek employment towards the end of your studies and have access to the annual AMTA conference and a number of workshops at discounted rates.

Confirm Your Course is Accredited

Please check the AMTA website to confirm that the course being studied is an accredited course. Only students enrolled in an accredited course may apply.

Registration Period

Student registration covers the 12 month period July 1 – June 31.

Applying for Student Membership

Student membership applications are found on the AMTA website. Applications include a signature from a lecturer at the course the applicant is enrolled in.

Application for Registration After Graduation

Registered Music Therapist (RMT) applications are only accepted from current financial student members of AMTA. If graduates are not financial student members of AMTA they will need to apply for student membership in addition to registration (see website for most recent fees). Applications are found on the AMTA website. Students MUST apply for registration within 12 months of course completion. Graduates submitting after 12 months will need to complete additional administrative requirements and may be required to undertake a further course of study prescribed by NRC.
